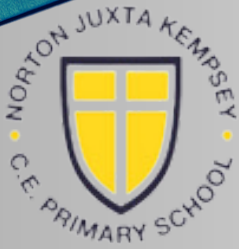
The approved summer uniform is outlined below. It is optional should pupils wish to wear these cooler items in the summer. All uniform should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
