What do the new Ofsted grades mean?

Ofsted have introduced a refreshed way of reporting outcomes, designed to give parents clearer and more detailed information about how schools are performing.

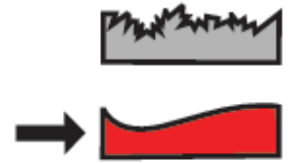
