When I exercise my heart beats faster, I get out of breath and I sweat.

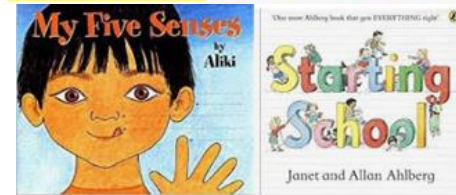
Exercise keeps me healthy.

Norton Juxta Kempsey Primary School.

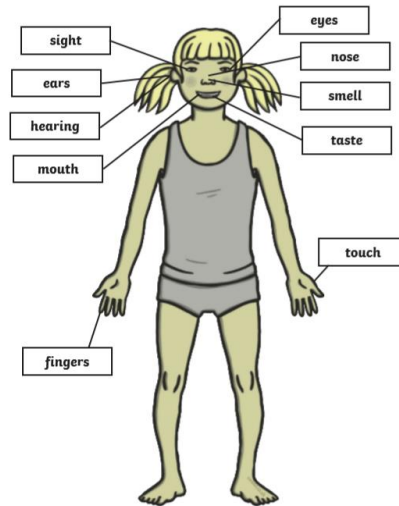

We have a village hall with a playground and café.



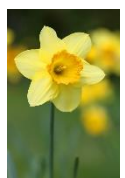
St Peter's Garden Centre sells and grows lots of different plants. Do you know these flowers?
