Interventions

Rapid phonics – new intervention for 2014/2015. All TAs and teachers were involved in the training for Rapid Phonics and TAs visited local Middle School to observe a Rapid Phonics group. Numicon – Implemented 2014/2015 into KS2. Next year (2015/2016) all classes will have Numicon as a tool to support pupils. All TA's have recently been up skilled and received training from HT and teachers will also be receiving training in the Autumn Term.
