Parent Consultation Evenings

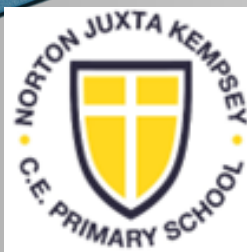
It was lovely to see you all at our parent meetings this week. We hope you enjoyed browsing at your child's books and looking at the beautiful displays in and around school.

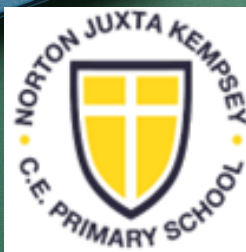


NJK Space Days - Thursday 20th and Friday 21st March
