Nut-Free Policy



NJK is a Nut-Free school. The school aims to protect children who have allergies to nuts while also helping them as they grow to take responsibility for what foods they can safely eat and to be aware of what foods may put them at risk. We do not allow nuts or nut products in school lunch boxes or for after school club snacks.

Please help...

Our "Nut-Free Policy" means that the following items should not be brought into the locality of the school:

- Packs of nuts
- Peanut butter or Nutella sandwiches
- Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
- Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts such as Reese's Peanut Butter Biscuits
- Cakes made with nuts
- Pastries covered in almonds – for example almond croissants
- Any home-cooked meals for packed lunches that are made from nuts
