## Cross Country

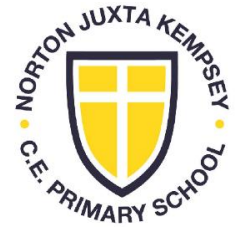
It has been a great start to the Cross Country season and wonderful to see so many enthusiastic runners! The results of the House cross country are:
