## **Information Letter 2- Summer Term 2021 – 2022**

### **Year 6 SATs Week Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May-12<sup>th</sup> May**

As a new primary school, this year is the first time we have administered the Key Stage Two Statutory Assessment Tests. I am pleased to report that all is going well. We received an unannounced monitoring visit by the local authority yesterday. Our procedures were found to be fully compliant and the pupils did us proud!

### **Year 6 Educational Visit to France**

Next week, the Year 6 pupils are going to France. This experience will really bring the subjects into perspective and relate their classroom learning to real-life experiences within a different cultural environment.

The trip will include excursions to:

- Honfleur – en route to Normandy (French language)
- The Bayeux Tapestry (Normans)
- William the Conqueror's castle (Normans)
- Arromanches 360Cinema (WW2)
- Arromanches landings (WW2)

### **Year 4 Educational Visit to West Malvern**

Our Year 4 pupils are traveling to Malvern Outdoor Education Centre tomorrow for an adventurous residential visit. They will take part in activities such as zip-line, high ropes and orienteering during the day and stay overnight at the centre.

### **Family Worship**

Parents are invited to attend our family services led by Revd Mark. Parents of pupils in Years 1, 3 and 5 are invited on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> May from 9.10am-9.30am and Years R, 2 and 4 at the same time on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Bikeability**

The pupils in Year 4 took part in a Bikeability course last week and thoroughly enjoyed it. Bikeability is cycle training designed to give children the skills and confidence to ride their bikes safely. Year 6 pupils have their Level 2 Bikeability course on 24<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> May. Many thanks to the PTA for funding this valuable activity.

### **School Bus**

### **Whole School Concert**

We have an exciting date for your diary... Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> June we will be hosting a whole school concert showcasing talent from across the school. In early June, all families will be issued with two tickets for the performance, which will begin at 1.30pm.



### Beginning and End of day Procedures

As part of the Covid Risk assessment, we introduced a one-way system at the beginning and end of day. From tomorrow, the former procedure for the end of day will be reintroduced. Here is a reminder:

- Willow Class- Parents wait in the EYFS outdoor area and collect pupils from the yellow classroom door (no change to current procedure). Exit back through the blue gate, not the one-way system around the school.
- Rowan Class- Parents wait in the Year 1 outdoor area and collect pupils from the yellow classroom door (no change to current procedure). Exit back through the blue gate, not the one-way system around the school.
- Hazel Class- Parents wait in the Year 2 outdoor area. Exit back through the blue gate, not the one-way system around the school. (No change to current procedure).
- Oak Class- Parents wait next to the two blue, picnic tables (Mrs Bilisland will be positioned there tomorrow to assist in the new routines). The pupils will be dismissed from the classroom door to you. Exit back through the blue gate, not the one-way system around the school.
- Parents of pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6 please wait on the main playground. The staff will bring the pupils out to meet you. If you have completed a permission to walk home letter (Years 5 and 6 only), your child will make their way through the blue gate by themselves.

All parents and pupils will be entering and exiting through the same blue gate. I will be on duty at the blue gate at the beginning and end of the day. I will open the gates at 3.05pm to allow time parents to go to the collection points.

### School Office

We will also be reopening the waiting area for parents. The yellow front door will be unlocked at 8.45am-9am and from 3pm-3.20pm for parents to visit the school office. **Please ensure that your child/ren arrives at school on time everyday so that we can lock the front door promptly at 9am.**
