Covid Update

Further to previous correspondence, I have been working with the Local Outbreak Response Team (LORT) to manage the cases of Covid we have in school. I stated last week that I would keep you informed of where the cases are. I have been notified of further positive PCR and LFTs:

- In Willow Class 2 pupils have had a positive PCR and 2 pupils positive LFT
- In Hazel Class 2 further notifications of positive PCRs
- In Oak Class 1 confirmation of a positive case by PCR following a positive LFT last week and another positive PCR
- In Rowan 1 positive PCR
- In Cedar 1 confirmation of a positive case by PCR following a positive LFT
- In Elm 1 positive PCR

The above have been reported to me over the weekend and the information subsequently submitted to the LORT. **If your child is in a class where there has been a positive case/s the advice is to book a PCR test, as stated in the 'Warn and Inform' Letter.**

Today, I have liaised with the other leaders in the trust and school governors to look at further measures which may include a short 'circuit break'. This would mean either a full or partial closure of the school and a shift to online learning. An immediate step, starting tomorrow, will be lunches in classrooms for all pupils.

I will continue to write to you regularly to keep you fully informed of the situation. In the meantime, thank you for your ongoing support.
