COVID Risk Assessments

The number of cases of COVID is rising nationally in schools. Please ensure that you remain as safe as possible in and around the school site, wearing face coverings and ensuring **you and your children remain 2m apart** from other families. The staff team continue to carry out lateral flow tests twice weekly.

Please can I request that where possible parents park and walk to school thus alleviating the congestion outside school. For those parked near to school, please move on as quickly and safely as possible to free up spaces for the next set of parents arriving.

Sport at NJK

Here is a reminder of some sporting events coming soon...

W/C 28th June – Year 3/4 District Virtual Athletics

Wednesday 30th June – Year 1 and 2 Cricket Skills Blast festival, run by All Stars Cricket coaches.

Thursday 8th July – Sports Day

We will be following the latest Public Health advice and the DFE Guidance which is to limit the amount of spectators per class to 30. As all members of the audience must remain seated at every event, it will be necessary to issue tickets and conduct a seating plan for track and trace purposes.

As we are unable to host all parents for the whole event the timings will be as follows:

EYFS pupils- 9.30-10am

Years 1 and 2 pupils-10.45-11.15am

Years 3 and 4 pupils-1.30-2pm

Years 5 and 6 pupils-2.30-3pm

I will be asking you to complete a ticket request form and there will be ONE ticket issued per family. Please note as the guidance requires spectators to be seated and that a maximum of 30 people attend per class, the tickets will be issued to **one parent** only and no younger siblings. Whilst the DFE Guidance states multiple groups of parents can attend outdoor events, the risk assessment carried out by the trust allows for two groups, in separate enclosures to be spectating at the same time.

Please note that if the guidance changes prior to these events it might not be possible to allow visitors on site.
