Remote Learning

We are very excited to host our initial class Teams meetings on Wednesday (Oak) and Friday (Hazel) this week. After half term all pupils will receive their login details and invitations to a class meeting. We are looking forward to using Teams meetings to keep in touch with the pupils on a weekly basis. It will run alongside Seesaw, with lessons continuing to be posted on Seesaw daily.

COVID-19 Symptoms/End of Half-Term

The DfE have requested that school leaders be on-call for the 3 days following the last teaching day to undertake test and trace arrangements in school, if notified of a positive COVID case. Please be vigilant about the symptoms this weekend:

- A high temperature
- A new and continuous cough
- A loss of smell or taste

After 3 days please follow this guidance:

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

For the first 3 days after teaching ends, if your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation therefore contact the school by email -office@nortonprimary.worcs.sch.uk or telephone the dedicated school number 07871 779132.
