Dear Parents,

As part of our Traditional Tales topic this half term we are planning an educational visit to Lower Smite Farm. The day will include

Investigating how our food grows and where other amazing plants can be found at Lower Smite Farm.

- Join in the story of The Little Red Hen
- Carry out simple experiments to find a good place to plant a seed.
- Have a go at grinding some wheat to make flour
- Make bread rolls to take home to taste
- Go on a farm walk - visit the wheat field and create a colourful Little Red Hen using natural materials.

The visit will take place on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February and we will leave school at about 9.30am returning in time for the end of the day at 3.10pm. **In order for this visit to go ahead we are asking for a contribution of £10.50 per child. This is to cover the cost of the day at Lower Smite (£5 per child) and the cost of the coach (£5.50 per child). If there are insufficient contributions to cover the cost of the visit it will not take place.**

Once back at school we will be completing lots of follow up work about our visit and you are invited into school on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> February to have a look at the children's work at 2.30pm.**

### **Children will need**

Warm 'home' clothes and school sweatshirt

Suitable waterproof coat, hat, scarf and gloves

Wellies

A drink and a small rucksack to carry their drink and lunch

A packed lunch (lunch will be provide for those children who would normally have hot dinners)
