TEACHERS' INDUSTRIAL ACTION – Tuesday 5th July

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware from the media, members of NUT have elected to take legal industrial action on the 5th July as a further step in their dispute over cuts in school funding, defence of national working conditions and for a national negotiating framework. The action (a one day strike) will result in class or whole school closures across the country.

The school has conducted a risk assessment to consider all options for maintaining provision taking account of the extent to which the health, safety and education of pupils can be maintained.

With the information currently available, it seems very likely that the school will close or partially close on the day of the industrial action. Parents should be aware that the school may need to re-deploy some staff to maintain our provision. As this is the day of the KS2 afternoon performance of 'We'll meet again' this will be rescheduled for Friday 8th July at 1.15pm. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

Since staff are not required to give advance notice of their intention to take industrial action, it is possible that this situation could change at short notice. Information about any such change will be provided on the school website and by text message.
