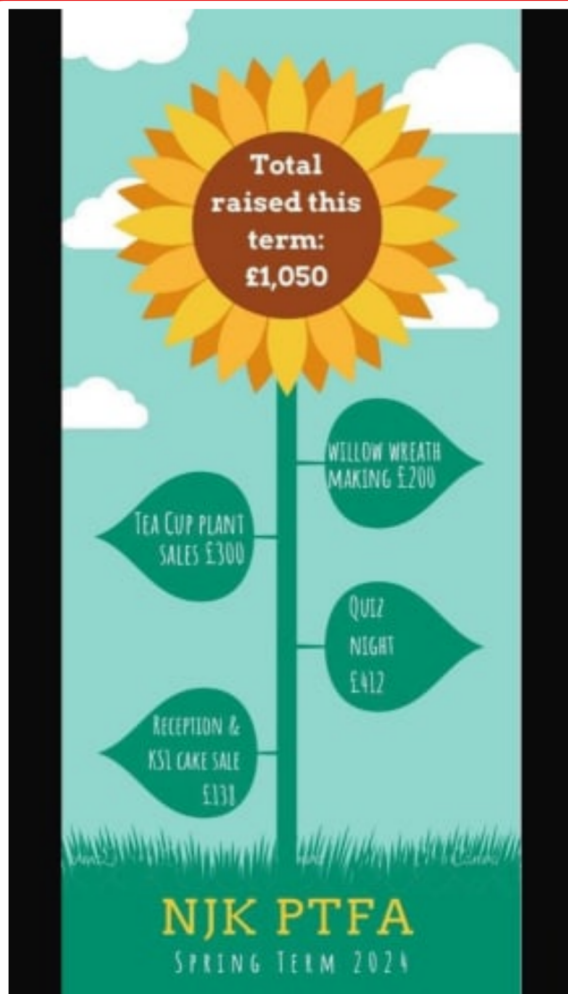
The next NJK PTFA meeting will be held on
