All pupils will be able to buy a key-ring and torch next week. It will come home gift wrapped, ready to gift.

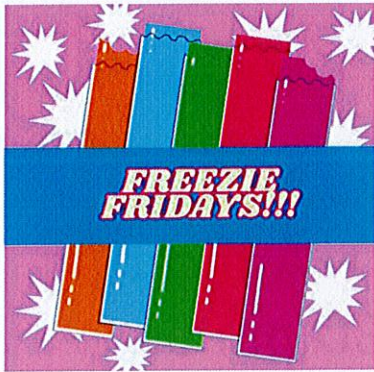

It was a pleasure to fund the Yr6 enterprises. They have raised over £700 for their end of year events.

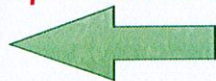



The Colour Run is coming to NJK and we can't wait. This fun vibrant event will be held at NJK school on

Thursday 2nd July at 1.30pm.

It will follow the family picnic on the school field which gives you - parents and family - the opportunity to join in - if you wish. Or you may just want to spectate!

This is a PTFA and NJK Staff run event during school time.

All classes will be taking part and a thorough risk assessment has been completed. This event is not only great fun but also an opportunity to raise the remaining money for the much needed laptops. Sponsorship from this event and the sale of raffle tickets and colour run photos will contribute towards this. Pupils will run a short course while being showered with coloured, non toxic, food grade powder. Please help your child gather sponsors - every contribution will really make a difference. Let's make it a day full of colour, fun and community spirit.

FAQ...

Can parents/family take part?

Yes, please feel free to join in with your child/ren, you can pay on the day.
The classes will be set off on a staggered start.

Do I have to take part if I'm there?

No. You are free to be a spectator.

Do I have to attend?

No, we appreciate that not all parents can attend all events - the event is being run in school time - all pupils will be supervised by staff - there is not a requirement for you to be there.

Is the powder safe?

The powder is made from cornflour, is vegan and GF, organic food grade dyes are used.
It is non-toxic. Powder has an EN71 certificate

Is this a competitive event?

No, this is about participation and fun.

There are no prizes for finishing first BUT all pupils will receive a fruit ice-lolly to help cool them down.

Can I take photos?

In line with school procedures and in keeping with expectations for other whole school events such as sports day and concerts - photography is not permitted.
However, a professional photographer can take photos at the end
- if you give prior permission.

How much does it cost to take part?

Nothing! This is a fully inclusive event. It is an expensive event to run but the profits made from raffle tickets sales, will be facilitating the purchase of 80kg of coloured powder from a reputable supplier.

What do my child/ren need to wear?

They will be in school PE kits in the morning for sports day. Following sports day there will be our annual picnic lunch on the field - parents are welcome to stay if they wish.
Pupils will be registered in classrooms following lunch and will have the opportunity to change. If you wish them to wear something other than their school PE kit for the colour run- please send this in with them on the day. A pair of sunglasses or swimming goggles is highly recommended - but powder will not deliberately be thrown in faces.

Can I take my child home after the run?

Yes, once all pupils have run, you will be able to take your very colourful child home!

It is a normal school day - so any pupils whose parents are not attending will stay in school as normal until 3.30pm.

ASC will run as normal on this day too.

My child doesn't want to get messy...

I don't want powder thrown at my child...

We will be setting up the route to allow anyone participating to avoid having powder thrown at them or being squirted with a water pistol. You can opt to avoid all colour stations or just some - depending on how colourful you want to be!
